1. Shrub, tree, plant, or grass: Shrub<sup>2</sup>
2. Perennial or annual: Perennial<sup>3</sup>
3. Plant Height: Maximum 6ft<sup>4</sup>
4. Bloom period: April to October<sup>5</sup>
5. Pollinators they attract: Birds and butterflies<sup>6</sup>
6. Edible to Humans: Yes (low amounts)<sup>7</sup>
7. Classification on endangered species list: N/A
8. Harbouring pests: Whiteflies, aphids, and scales<sup>8</sup>
9. Soil type requirements: Any<sup>9</sup>
10. Soil pH requirements: Any<sup>10</sup>
11. Hardiness zone: 5 to 9<sup>11</sup>
12. Wet/dry requirements: Well drained<sup>12</sup>
13. Watering: Keep soil moist<sup>13</sup>
14. Shade/Sun Requirements: Any, prefers partial shade<sup>14</sup>
15. Precautions: Rust, leaf spots, chlorosis (pH too alkaline), and scorched leaves (if too hot)<sup>15</sup>
16. Companions: N/A
17. Additional Info: Deer resistant<sup>16</sup>
