3. Plant Height: 3 to 8 ft⁴
4. Bloom period: June to September⁵
5. Pollinators they attract: Birds⁶

8. Harbouring pests: Japanese beetles⁸
9. Soil type requirements: Gravel, sandy, or deep forest loam⁹
